NOTICE OF RACE

1 RULES — The regattas will be governed by the 'rules' as defined in the Racing Rules of Sailing (RRS). The regattas is designated Category A.

2 ENTRIES AND ELIGIBILITY —

2.1 - The regattas are open to current members of the ISCYRA.

2.2 - The entry fee for the 64rd Tulip Tune-up is \$175 payable to the Gull Lake Country Club, and includes trophies, continental breakfast, and box lunches on Saturday and lunch on Sunday.

4 ALTERATIONS TO THE RRS — (this list may not be complete)

4.1 - Race Signal AP will be changed so that, when made ashore, it means; “The race is postponed. The warning signal will be made not less than thirty (30) minutes after AP is lowered.” Signals made ashore will be displayed from RC Signal boat, while docked.

4.2 - Appendix A 4.1 will be changed so that a boat starting later than ten (10) minutes after her starting signal will be scored Did Not Start.

4.3 - RRS 35 and Appendix A4.1 will be changed so that —

a) The time limit will be two and one-half (2 1/2) hours. Boats failing to finish within thirty (30) minutes after the first boat finishes or within the time limit, whichever is later, will be scored Did Not Finish (DNF).

b) When the first boat has not completed the first leg within forty-five (45) minutes after the start, the race will be abandoned.

4.5 - Appendix A will be changed so that each boat's series score will be the total of her race scores.

5 SAILING INSTRUCTIONS — will be available at registration.

6 COURSES — will be according to STCR 34.

7 SCORING — The Low Point scoring system of Appendix A will apply, modified so that each boat's series score will be the total of her race scores. No score(s) will be excluded. Five (5) races are scheduled for the 63rd Tulip Tune-up. One (1) race is required to be completed to constitute a series.

8 PRIZES — will be awarded to the Skipper and Crew of the top five (5) finishers in the regatta and will be the traditional Tulip Tune-Up Wooden Shoes.

9 DISCLAIMER OF LIABILITY — Competitors participate in the regatta entirely at their own risk. See RRS 4, Decision to Race. The organizing authority and the host yacht club and fleet will not accept any liability for material damage or personal injury or death sustained in conjunction with or prior to, during, or after the regatta.
