### Early Bird Notice of Race Niantic Bay Yacht Club Sunday, June 3, 2018



#### 1. RULES

1.1 This event will be governed by the Racing Rules of Sailing.

The Niantic Bay Yacht Club is the Organizing Authority.

- 1.2 This event is an ECSA points regatta. Members' results will be forwarded to ECSA.
- 1.3 This event is a Pre-Soundings Cup points regatta.

Qualification requires finishing both the Early Bird and Thames Yacht Club's Commodore's Trophy race.

#### 2. ELIGIBILITY AND ENTRY

- 2.1 ECSA Membership is not required
- 2.2 This event is open to all monohulls and to Ensign and Atlantic class boats.

Other boats/classes will be considered.

ECSA Members must have a valid ECSA/PHRF certificate on file at ECSA.net.

2.3 Participants may register for classes and party tickets online at <a href="www.nbyc.org">www.nbyc.org</a>, open the NOR flyer and then follow link to register.

- 2.5 Entry Deadline is Friday, June 1st at 1800.

#### 3. FEES

- 3.1 The Entry Fee is \$55 per boat. Or save \$5 if you're a US Sailing members and pay just \$50.
- 3.2 Entry fee can be waived for skippers sponsoring a "new guest." Inquire for eligibility.

  Note: A "new guest" did not race last year and is not a NBYC member.
- 3.3 Party tickets are \$10 each, or \$5 each for those under 21.

#### 4. SCHEDULE

- 4.1 First warning is scheduled at 1100 on Sunday, June 3, 2016.
- 4.2 Sailing Instructions will be posted at www.nbyc.org by 1800 Wednesday May 28th, 2016.
- 4.3 The unofficial Scratch Sheet will be actively building on line at Yachtscoring.com and will be finalized by the Race Committee by 1800 on Saturday, June 3rd.
- 4.3 Multiple races are possible for any class, at the discretion of the Race Committee.

#### 5. MEASUREMENTS

5.1 The Race Committee will assign ratings and classes.

#### 6. VENUE

6.1 Racing will take place in Niantic Bay and Fisher's and Long Island Sounds.

#### 7. THE COURSES

7.1 Courses will be selected by the Race Committee based on weather conditions.

The marks will be identified in the Sailing Instructions and will be a combination of government marks and drop marks.

#### 8. SCORING

- 8.1 Time-on-Time calculation will be used to score the PHRF classes.
- 8.2 There will be no throw-outs. This changes RRS Appendix A2.

#### 9. BERTHING

9.1 Free guest moorings are available at the Niantic Bay Yacht Club for the week preceding the Early Bird and/or afterwards until Off Soundings. For reservations, contact the club manager at 860-739-0558

#### 10. PRIZES AND "SIREN'S TEMPTATION" PARTY

- 10.1 The top 3 finishers in each class will receive trophies at the Awards Party following racing at Niantic Bay Yacht Club.
- 10.2 The top finisher in each of the following categories will receive a trophy at the Awards Party Youth Crew (all aboard age 29 or younger) and Green Skipper (No ECSA races 2007-2017).
