SANDPIPER NATIONAL CHAMPIONSHIP REGATTA

JULY 25TH - JULY 29, 2018

The 2018 National Championship of the Sandpiper Class will be held July 25-29. Regatta headquarters will be the Mantoloking Yacht Club, Mantoloking, New Jersey with racing on upper Barnegat Bay. The Organizing Authorities (OA) are the host clubs Bay Head Yacht Club, Mantoloking Yacht Club, Metedeconk River Yacht Club, and Normandy Beach Yacht Club.



NOTICE OF RACE

1. RULES

The regatta will be governed by the rules as defined in the 2017-2020 Racing Rules of Sailing (RRS), the prescriptions of US Sailing, the rules of the Sandpiper Class Association, and this Notice Of Race, except as any of these are changed by the Sailing Instructions or any appendices to the Sailing Instructions.

2. ELIGIBILITY & ENTRY

- 2.1 AGE The regatta is open to competitors of all ages. All Competitors are required to sign a Waiver of Liability. All Skippers under the age of 18 shall be required to submit a completed Waiver of Liability signed by his/her parent or guardian.
- **2.2** US SAILING MEMBERSHIP All skippers at this regatta will be required to be members of US Sailing and 2018 paid Members of the Sandpiper Class National Dues.
- **2.3** CLASS ASSOCIATION MEMBERSHIP All skippers at this regatta shall be required to be up to date paid Members of the Sandpiper Class Association.

3. BOATS/MEASUREMENT

3.1 The regatta is open to Marshall Sandpipers conforming to the rules of the Sandpiper Class Association. There will be sufficient land storage for all

competing boats at Mantoloking YC. The same crew must sail in all races of the regatta. If a crewmember is not able to continue racing, a substitute may be allowed by petition to the Race Committee.

- 3.2 CHARTERS Competitors are encouraged to bring their own boats. A limited number of charter boats may be available. If interested contact Dan Hurley the charter coordinator (732)-598-0373.
- 3.3 EQUIPMENT CHECK All boats must complete a Required Equipment check at registration in which they will be required to show proof of each item on a Required Equipment list including towline of at least 30′, bilge pump, bucket, paddle, suitable anchor and anchor line, whistle, life vests for each crewmember, and a VHF radio.
- SAIL MEASUREMENT All sails used in this regatta will be subject to a Class Association compliance check at any point before, during or after the regatta.
- RESPONSIBILITY Each competitor will be responsible for ensuring their boat is in compliance with the Sandpiper Class Association Rules.

4. FEES

The entry fee for the regatta is \$300.00 per boat. The entry fee includes breakfast, lunch and dinner on the first two race days. On Saturday the final race day, breakfast and lunch are available together with beverages and heavy appetizers to be served at the Afternoon Awards following the last race. In addition, two long sleeve sailing shirts will be distributed at check in. More than two crewmembers can be added at \$150.00 each. Spouses of competitors will be able to attend the evening events for a per event charge to be listed on the registration form.

8. SCORING

A maximum of 8 races are scheduled, of which one shall be completed to constitute a series. If 5 or more races are sailed, a boat's worst score shall be discarded.

9. PRIZES

Prizes will be awarded to skippers and one crew placing first through fifth. The Sandpiper National Championship Perpetual Trophy will be awarded to the winner of the regatta.
