#### 1 RULES

- 1.1 The regatta will be governed by the *rules* as defined in *The Racing Rules of Sailing 2009-2012*, the current IRC Rules and the current PHRF Regulations as administered by the YRA of LIS.
- 1.2 Handicap boats shall observe the Minimum Equipment Recommendations of YRA of LIS, Category C.
- 1.3 All keelboats are required to carry a radio capable of transmitting and receiving on VHF channel 72 or as stated in the Sailing instructions.
- 1.4 Part 5 Section B of the RRS is changed to provide for arbitration of the rules of Part 2.

#### 2 ENTRIES

- 2.1 Eligible boats may enter by registering online with <a href="http://wch.regatta.llsevent.org/">http://wch.regatta.llsevent.org/</a>
  or <a href="https://wch.regatta.llsevent.org/">www.yachtscoring.com</a> or on approved entry forms received at the Larchmont Yacht Club front desk. All entries must be received no later than 1700 Friday September 7, 2012. All entries not submitted on line shall be mailed to the Larchmont Yacht Club, 1 Woodbine Avenue, Larchmont, NY 10538 or faxed to914-468-7751 Faxed entries will be accepted only with a valid signature for credit card authorization.
- 2.2 The Entry Fees will include 1 ticket for the Regatta Post-Race Party with Silent Auction on Saturday September 8, 2012. Additional tickets \$75.00 for adults, \$50.00 for juniors (ages 18 & under) Entry Fees:

Cruising Boats and One Design Keelboats: \$120.00
One Design Centerboard Boats; \$110.00
Optimist \$100.00
Optimist Green Fleet (Saturday racing only) \$75.00

- 2.3 At the discretion of the race committee, divisions may be subdivided into classes.
- 2.4 The non-spinnaker division is open to boats with a PHRF rating of 50 and above. Both the Non-spinnaker and the Double-handed divisions will be scored PHRF.
- 2.5 All handicapped entries must be accompanied by their PHRF or IRC rating. IRC certificates do not need to be endorsed. Boats without a PHRF rating will be assigned a rating based upon similar boats. The rating assigned by the race committee shall not be grounds for requesting redress. This changes rule 62.1
- 2.6 Preliminary scratch sheets listing the boats by their divisions and class will be available online or at the front desk by 1800 the day before the race and before the starting sequence from one of the committee boats.

#### 5 START AND FINISH

The starting and finish line will be located south of the Larchmont Breakwater. Individual Class race circles will be in the waters off Larchmont Harbor.

#### 6 COURSES

- 6.1 The courses will be as described in the Sailing Instructions.
- Keelboats: The race committee intends to run the race committee a short/medium distance race one day and windward/ leeward course on the alternate day, depending on weather conditions.
- 6.3 One Design Centerboard Boats: Courses will be windward/leewards.
- 6.4 Optimist & Green Fleet: Courses will be trapezoids or triangles.

#### 7 TIME LIMIT

- 7.1 The time limit for the short/medium distance race will be 1700 for all classes.
- 7.2 Time limit for other courses will be as stated in the sailing instructions.

#### 8 SCORING

- 8.1 For PHRF time allowances will be computed using time on distance.
- 8.2 For IRC the boats rating allowance will be applied as a factor of the elapsed time.
- 8.3 Boats sailing one-design level racing will be scored by class.
- 8.4 A boat's series score will be the total of her race scores with no throw outs.

#### 9 PRIZES

- 9.1 Series prizes will be awarded to the first three finishers in each division if there four or more entries in that division.
- 9.2 Presentation of awards will take place at Larchmont Yacht Club on Sunday, September 9 after racing.

#### 10 GUEST MOORINGS AND PRIVILEGES

- 10.1 Guest moorings will be available on a first come basis at no charge. Please contact the Waterfront Director at the Larchmont Yacht Club for reservations at 914-468-7756 or email: moorings@larchmontyc.org
- 10.2 The privileges of the Club will be extended to owners and crews of competing boats.
