NOTICE OF RACE

The 2018 Lorna Whittelsey Weekend Series is composed of two events:

- Saturday, September 8: Lorna Whittelsey Women's Regatta
- Sunday, September 9: Lorna Sunday "Distance" Race
- One entry fee includes both events
- · Substitutions allowed for Sunday

1. LORNA WHITTELSEY WOMEN'S REGATTA (LWWR)

- 1.1. Multiple races around dropped marks
- 1.2. Windward/leeward likely
- 1.3. Additional prize for best performance by a past or present Commodore, Vice Commodore or Rear Commodore
- 1.4. Part of the YRALIS Women's Trophy, the Andrea Watson Award, for the overall best performance in the Queen's Cup, Gillespie Regatta, Lorna Whittelsey Women's Regatta, and Mendez Trophy
- 1.5. Further details in the Lorna Whittelsey Women's Regatta Sailing Instructions

2. LORNA SUNDAY "DISTANCE" RACE (LSDR)

- 2.1. One race around dropped marks, fixed Captain Harbor racing marks or government marks
- 2.2. Irregular combinations of windward, reaching and downwind likely
- 2.3. Two hours targeted to sail the course
- 2.4. Further details in the Lorna Sunday "Distance" Race Sailing Instructions

3. RULES

- 3.1. Racing will be governed by the Racing Rules of Sailing
- 3.2. Per rule 90.2(c), the sailing instructions may be changed on the water up until the warning signal
- 3.3. Under RRS 87, class rule 13.4 Number of Crew is changed as follows: for the LWWR, the boat shall be raced with two women; for the LSDR, the boat shall be raced with two or three women
- 3.4. Appendix T and US Sailing Prescription Appendix V shall apply
- 3.5. All boats shall carry an operational VHF radio and monitor #71 while on the water

4. ELIGIBILITY, ENTRY & FEES

- 4.1. Both events are open to boats of the Ideal 18 class
- 4.2. All competitors shall be women and the helmswomen shall be 18 years or older by September 8, 2018
- 4.3. Entry shall be by registering online at www.yachtscoring.com
- 4.4. The entry fee for the Series is \$240.00 for registrations by 8/25/18, \$270 after that date.
 - 4.4.1. Entry fee includes lunch and dinner for two on Saturday and brunch for two on Sunday

4.4.2. Additional dinner tickets are \$55.00 and additional brunch tickets are \$35.00 and may be purchased by making a reservation with the Indian Harbor Yacht Club Front Desk (203) 869-2484

5. **LOANER BOATS**

- 5.1. A limited number of loaner boats will be available on a first come/first served basis
- 5.2. Competitors interested in securing a loaner boat should contact Elizabeth O'Toole (see notice 14)
- 5.3. The Indian Harbor fleet will be added to the loaner boat pool
- 5.4. Additional boats will be secured by the Organizing Authority and added to the loaner boat loog
- 5.5. All Indian Harbor member competitors and other loaner boat competitors will be randomly assigned boats from the loaner boat pool
- 5.6. All participants in the loaner boat pool shall provide the Organizing Authority with a credit card to cover the damage deposit of \$500.00 per incident, which, if not needed, will be disposed of after racing

7. **SAILING INSTRUCTIONS**

Sailing Instructions for each event will be available, beginning on or before September 8, online via www.yachtscoring.com

8. **VENUE & COURSES**

- 8.1. Racing will be held inside Captain Harbor and, for the LSDR, may also be held outside the islands
- 8.2. Courses will be described in the Sailing Instructions

9. **PENALTY SYSTEM**

US Sailing Appendix V applies whereby the first two sentences of rule 44.1 are changed to: 'A boat may take a One-Turn Penalty when she may have broken one or more rules of Part 2 or rule 31 in an incident while racing. However, when she may have broken one or more rules of Part 2 while in the zone around a mark other than a starting mark, her penalty shall be a Two-Turns Penalty.'

10. LWWR SCORING:

- 10.1. The scoring system will use Appendix A2
- 10.2. One race is required to be completed to constitute a series
- 10.3. All races shall count. This changes Appendix A2.1

PRIZES 11.

- 11.1. Prizes will be awarded for first through third for both events
- The LWWR and Commodore's prizes will be awarded at the LWWR dinner 11.2.
- 11.3. The LSDR will be awarded at the LSDR brunch

12. HOUSING

Efforts will be made to provide housing for out-of-area sailors, if requested by August 31. Competitors interested in housing should contact Housing Chair Anne Alam at annealam5@gmail.com
