NOTICE OF RACE

1. Organizing Authority and Rules

The organizing authority is Crescent Sail Yacht Club in affiliation with the United States Formula 18 Association. The regatta will be governed by rules as defined by the Racing Rules of Sailing (RRS). This is an International Event, therefore pursuant to the US Sailing prescription to RRS 88.2 (changes to prescriptions), the US Sailing prescription to RRS 40 (personal flotation devices) is deleted. 2. Advertising

Boats may be required to display advertising chosen and supplied by the organizing authority.

3. Eligibility and Entry

The event is open to <u>all</u> F18 catamarans conforming to the International Formula 18 Class Rules. Crew and skipper must be current members of their national F18 Class Association.

4. Fees

\$299 if paid before April 1st
\$350 if paid before August 1st
\$400 on or after August 1st **Cancelation** fee is \$50 before July 1st. \$100 thereafter.

5. Racing Schedule and Format

For those that are interested in a warm-up event, there will be a catamaran regatta at CSYC the preceding weekend (Sep 7-8). For details please refer to <u>http://cramsailing.com/regattas/schedule/</u>.

There will be 4 days of championship racing with the objective to hold 3-5 races per day. Three (3) races are required to be completed to constitute a championship. On Thursday, September 19th no warning signal will be made after 3 PM. Sailing instructions will be available at check-in.

6. Measurement

Boats and crews will be weighed as part of the check-in. Competitors are responsible for ensuring their equipment is class legal. During the competition, any boat or crew weight may be subject to inspection by a designated technical official.

No primary measurements will be made at the event unless previously arranged with an official F18 class measurer. <u>Please contact Scott Miller, USF18 Chief Measurer for information regarding measurement</u> for this event at millerscottb@gmail.com or 858-337-9917 at least one month before the regatta.

7. Insurance

Each participating boat shall have current third-party liability insurance with a minimum coverage of not less than \$300,000 USD. Proof of insurance must be presented at registration.

8. Venue

Crescent Sail Yacht Club, 276 Lakeshore Road. Grosse Pointe Farms, MI 48236. Racing will take place on Lake St. Clair which is a significant body of water roughly 20miles in diameter.

9. Radio Communications

Competitors may carry a VHF radio for safety purposes. Its use and restrictions will be defined in the sailing instructions.

10. Awards

The top placing team shall be named the 2019 F18 North American Champion. There will be awards for the top placing all female, mixed, youth (both, skipper and crew younger than 23 years old) and masters teams (both, skipper and crew 50 years or older).

11. Social Schedule

Details on the social schedule will be published before May 1st, 2019. A dinner cruise on Lake St. Clair / Detroit River is tentatively planned for one weeknight after racing.
