ENTRY AND ELIGIBILITY

- Entries are open to all RSX sailors men, women, and youth (under 22 years as of December 31, 2019)
- In order to be accepted, each registration must be duly completed with the entry form (online or on-site), the liability waiver signed (on-site) and the payment of the adequate registration fee.
- Registration can be made online at www.YachtScoring.com until Jan. 20 and on-site on Jan. 21 (1730-1900).

REGISTRATION FEE

- \$65⁰⁰ Until January 18 (online early entry fee).
- \$75⁰⁰ January 19 to January 21 (online regular entry fee).
- Entry fees are determined by payment date, not by registration date.

SAILING INSTRUCTIONS - Sailing Instructions will be available on-site and on the Official Notice Board.

VENUE - Competitors may sail from the Biscayne Bay Yacht Club. The regatta will be on the Biscayne Bay.

COURSES - As per Sailing Instructions.

SCORING

- World Sailing Low Point Scoring shall be used.
- RC will attempt six (6) races. One scored race constitutes a regatta.

<u>PRIZES</u> - Top 3 Men, top 3 Women, and a Coach's Award for the best behaved/helpful coach. North American titles shall only be granted to the highest placing nationals from North America (men, women, & youth)

SAFETY – Competitors must pass Race Committee on starboard and hail their sail number before the start of the first race each day. Coaches must monitor their radios and be available to assist in case of emergency.

<u>EQUIPMENT & COACH BOAT LOGISTICS</u> -Competitors are permitted to bring equipment to the venue, the evening of January 21. Equipment may be placed in designated areas only. Coach boats may deliver sailors and equipment to club docks, but are not permitted to tie-up to the docks. There is limited space for coach boats on the side of the club. Coach boats may dock at the US Sailing Center. There is no coach boat fee.
