# 1. RULES

- 1.1. The regatta will be governed by the rules as defined in *The Racing Rules of Sailing* (RRS).
- 1.2. The Equipment Rules of Sailing will apply.
- 1.3. The Rules of the IM24CA will apply.

#### 2. ELIGIBILITY AND ENTRY

The regatta is open to all boats of the Melges 24 class that meet the obligations of the Class Rules and, when relevant, their Member National Authority.

#### 3. FEES

The Entry Fee will be: \$125. Includes Tuning Clinic, Regatta Racing, and 4 meal tickets for Saturday dinner (Extra meal tickets can be purchased for \$20 during registration)

#### 4. SCHEDULE

FRIDAY, May 3

1200-1700: Melges 24 Tuning Clinic with Jackson Benvenutti, North Sails One Design LA. *Includes on-the-water drills and coaching throughout the regatta, followed by debriefing sessions each evening*

#### 5. SCORING

5.1 Regatta Scoring - the regatta will be scored as governed in appendix A of the racing rules, using the low points system. One race is required to be completed to constitute a series. When fewer than six races have been completed, a boat's series score will be the total of her race scores. When six or more races have been completed, a boat's series score will be the total of her race scores excluding her worst score.

**Alternative Penalties:** RRS 44.1 and 44.2 are changed so that only one turn, including one tack and one jibe is required.

#### **6. SAILING INSTRUCTIONS**

Sailing Instructions (SIs) will be available at registration. Notices to competitors will be posted on the Official Race Information Notice Board located inside the Lake Lanier Sailing Clubhouse. Changes in the sailing instructions will be posted on the LLSC Clubhouse bulletin board one hour prior to the start of the first race each day.

#### 7. LIABILITY

The Safety of the boat and crew shall be the sole responsibility of the boat's owner and/or owner's representative. Skipper and crew assume the risks of racing and agree not to sue race administrators. Skipper is responsible for conduct of crew.

# 8. DOCKAGE & LAUNCHING

Provided by Lake Lanier Sailing Club, included in registration fee. Boats may use the Lake Lanier Sailing Clubs launching ramp, and may dock overnight both Friday and Saturday using the outside (opposite ramp side) of the Dock located at the front entrance launch ramp, or other designated docks.
