
## SAILING INSTRUCTIONS ADDENDUM COURSE ILLUSTRATIONS

- 1. The symbol "+G" displayed on the course board after the numerical course designation signifies that a gate will be set at the leeward mark. Boats must pass through the gate marks from the direction of the previous mark, rounding the port gate mark to port or the starboard gate mark to starboard. In the event that a signaled gate is not set, boats are to round the existing Leeward Mark to Port.
- 2. The symbol **"+O"** displayed on the course board after the numerical course designation signifies that an offset mark is to be left to port in conjunction with the rounding of the weather mark.



## The Round the Island Race

- 1. The Race Committee will announce the Round the Island Race over Fleet VHF channels at 0830 (Harbor Signals).
- 2. Channel 71 will be the one designated VHF Channel for the Round The Island Race
- 3 .Course "A" Counter Clockwise Around Block Island:

After the first mark, if added, the following are the marks of the course that must be left to port:

- a. Red Bell "6" approx. 0.3 mile W of Southwest Point.
- b. Red Whistle "4" approx. 1.0 mile SW of Southwest Point.
- c. Red Nun "2" approx. 0.4 mile SSW of Black Rock Point.
- d. Special Mark "A" at approx. N 41° 8.4' W 071° 34.0
- e. Special Mark "B" at approx. N 41° 8.8' W 071° 32.8
- f. Special Mark "C" at approx. N 41° 9.3' W 071° 32.4
- g. Special Mark "D" at approx. N 41° 9.9' W 071° 31.9
- h. Green Bell "1" N off Old Harbor.
- i. Green Can "7" N off Clay Head.
- j. Green Bell "1BI " off North Reef.
- 4. Course "C" Clockwise Around Block Island:

After the first mark, if added, marks of the course shall be left to starboard in the reverse order designated in Course "A".

- 5. A first mark may be added and will be signaled by posting a bearing and range. If a first mark is added, it is to be left on the same hand as the other marks of the course.
- 6. The Finish Line for the Around the Island Race will be in the vicinity of the Starting Line.
