Change of Course Mark will be: Yellow Tetrahedron

TIME LIMITS – SI 12

Mark 1 Time Limit: If the first boat in each class does not pass Mark 1 within 30 minutes of its start the race for that class will be abandoned

Race Time Limit: The time limit for the first boat, in each class to sail the course and finish 90 minutes

Finishing Window: The time limit for boats to finish after the first boat in a class has sailed the course and finished is 20 minutes
