PRELIMINARY NOTICE OF RACE

1.0 AUTHORITY

- 1.1 This regatta is organized under the authority of the Lauderdale Yacht Club and will be sailed under the management of the Race Committee. The regatta will be governed by the current **Racing Rules of Sailing (RRS)**, the prescriptions of US Sailing when they apply, the rules of International Finn Class, the International 29'r class, the International 49'r class, the International Laser Radial Class, and the International Laser Class, except as any of these are changed by the Notice of Race or the Sailing Instructions and properly posted amendments thereto.
- 1.2 The regatta will conform to the current ISAF Regulation 20 and the respective Class Rules.

2.0 ENTRY / CLASSES: International Finn Dinghy (open), and International Laser Radial (open, women will be scored for their North American Championships), International Laser Full Rig (open), International 29'r (open), International 49'r (open), International 470 (open). Each class must have a minimum of 5 entries.

2.1 Individuals who complete registration with the Lauderdale Yacht Club's Race Committee are eligible to compete. Sailing Instructions will be available to competitors that complete registration and will include a description of the courses to be sailed and other event information. Entries may be faxed, mailed or delivered in person to the attn. of the Sailing Master at Lauderdale Yacht Club. An entry form is available on LYC's website: www.LYC.org

4.0 ENTRY FEE

4.3 \$130 per singlehanded entry, \$160 per doublehanded entry. Entry fee includes Florida State Sales Tax. Early entry fee discount is \$15.00 if **RECEIVED** before January 19th, 2013.

5.1 The skipper's meeting will be held on Friday, February 8, 2013 at 0915 hrs at the LYC Sailing Center meeting room (upstairs).

7.0 EVENT CATEGORY

7.1 The regatta is designated a Category C event (RRS Appendix I, Regulation 20)

8.0 SCORING SYSTEM

8.1 The Low Point scoring system, rule A2 will apply, modified so that each boat's series score will be the total of her race scores, with her worst score discarded if five or more races have been completed. Seven or more races are scheduled, of which two races shall be completed to constitute a series.

9.0 PRIZES

9.1 First place, second place, and third place in each class. At the discretion of the R/C, a minimum of 5 boats may be required to constitute a class. (Men's and Women's Radials will be started together)
