Bronte Rocks Regatta

Notice of Race

Host: The Bronte Harbour Yacht Club (BHYC)

Date: August 31st and September 1st, 2013

Rules: The regatta will be governed by the current Racing Rules of Sailing.

Eligibility and Entry: The regatta is open to all yachts 20' and over, Sharks and limited one design fleets. Handicap racing will be conducted under both PHRF and IRC. Handicapped racing is restricted to yachts with valid PHRF Certificates or endorsed IRC Certificates. Those yachts competing in the Cruising Division will be assigned a rating if they do not have a valid PHRF Certificate.

The Organizing Authority has the right to deny entry to any yacht.

Single-handed sailing is specifically prohibited.

Entry Fee: Early Bird entry fee is \$75.00 (plus HST) until August 22nd. After August 22nd, the Entry Fee is \$100.00 (plus HST).

Registration: Registration can be submitted online at <u>www.yachtscoring.com</u> or at BHYC between 1800h and 2200h on Friday August 30th or at BHYC between 0800h and 0900h on Saturday August 31st. **Competitors Meeting:** There will be a Competitors Meeting at 0930h on August 31st in the regatta tent.

Sailing Instructions: Final Sailing Instructions will be made available immediately prior to the Competitors Meeting.

Schedule of Races: The scheduled time for the warning signal for the first race each day is 1100h. No warning signal will be made after 1500h on either day.

Venue: Dockage will be available only to those who have completed registration for the regatta. This dockage is provided by Bronte Harbour Yacht Club based on availability at the time of the regatta. Additional overflow dockage will be available at the Bronte Outer Harbour Marina. Competitors shall follow the directions of the BHYC Dock Master. Use VHF channel 68 to contact the BHYC Dock Master.

All racing will take place on two separate courses approximately 1.5 nautical miles south of the entrance to the harbour.

Racing: There will be a maximum of five races sailed in the regatta. A minimum of one completed race will constitute a series.

Scoring: The Low Point scoring system will be applied, modified so that each yacht's series score shall be the total of her scores for each race, with her worst score discarded if 4 or more races have been completed.

Awards: Series prizes for the first 3 places in each division will be awarded at the Awards Ceremony to take place as soon as possible after the racing. Other special trophies will be awarded at the presentation ceremony.

Disclaimer of Liability: Competitors participate in the regatta entirely at their own risk (see Rule 4). The organizing authority will not accept any liability for material damage or personal injury or death sustained in conjunction with or prior to, during, or after the regatta.

Insurance: Each participating boat shall be insured with and provide proof of a minimum coverage of Canadian \$2,000,000 per event or the equivalent.
