NOTICE OF RACE

1.0 AUTHORITY

- 1.1 This regatta is organized under the authority of the Lauderdale Yacht Club and will be sailed under the management of the Race Committee. The regatta will be governed by the current ***Racing Rules of Sailing (RRS)***, the prescriptions of US Sailing, and the rules of the International Finn Class.
- 1.2 The regatta will conform to the current ISAF Regulation 20 and the respective Class Rules.

2.0 ENTRY / CLASSES: International Finn Dinghy (Masters)

Individuals who comply with the Finn Class definition of "Master" and complete registration with the Lauderdale Yacht Club's Race Committee are eligible to compete. Sailing Instructions will be available to competitors that complete registration and will include a description of the courses to be sailed and other event information. Entries may be faxed, mailed, e-mailed or delivered in person to the attn. of the Sailing Master at Lauderdale Yacht Club. An entry form is available on LYC's website: www.LYC.org.

All competitors who pre-register MUST complete the registration process on-site.

4.0 ENTRY FEE

\$150 per entry (includes Florida State Sales Tax). Early entry fee discount is \$15.00 if **RECEIVED** before March 6, 2013.

Please note that due to LYC's schedule as host for other activities, competitors are not permitted to arrive at the regatta venue until 0900 Tuesday, March 5, 2013, for training.

7.0 SCORING SYSTEM

The Low Point scoring system, rule A2 will apply, modified so that each boat's series score will be the total of her race scores, with her worst score discarded if five or more races have been completed. Seven races are scheduled, of which two must be completed to constitute a regatta.

Prizes will be awarded to first, second, and third place in each class.
