## **NOTICE OF RACE**

with Amendment No. 1

## 1 RULES

- 1.1 Racing shall be governed by the Rules as defined in the Racing Rules of Sailing.
- 1.2 Neither spinnakers nor double headsails are permitted in the Leukemia Cruising Class. Entrants with racing experience are not permitted in the Leukemia Class; they shall participate in other classes.
- 1.3 PHRF N competitors only may use double headsails.
- 1.4 The notation "[NP]" in a rule in this Notice of Race means that a boat may not protest another boat for breaking that rule. This changes RRS 60.1(a).
- 1.5 **[NP]** Eastport Yacht Club (EYC) recommends that each competitor review and prepare their boat to the U.S. Sailing Safety Equipment Requirements, Nearshore. ## 2 ELIGIBILITY AND ENTRY

2.1 The Annapolis-area racing is open to boats in the following classes:

PHRF A0/A1 PHRF N Herreshoff 12.5 J/105
PHRF A2 Alerion Express 28 J/80 Multihull A
PHRF B Cal 25 J/30 Multihull B

PHRF C Harbor 20 J/35 Leukemia Cruising Class

CRCA-ORR (Cruiser; Non-Spinnaker; Performance Cruiser; Racer-Cruiser) CRCA-ARC (Non-Spinnaker; Spinnaker)

- 2.2 The Herring Bay, Miles River, and Rock Creek fleets each are open to boats in the following classes:

  PHRF Spinnaker

  PHRF Non-Spinnaker
- 2.3 Starts from Herring Bay and/or Miles River and/or Rock Creek will be run provided that a minimum of three (3) paid registrations must be received by 2000 hours on Thursday, 30 May 2019.



#### 3 FEES

- The fee is \$150 and includes a skipper's bag one (1) **Skipper's Entry Ticket** to the Rock the Dock Party. For more information about benefits included in the skipper bag and Entry Ticket, see the ADDITIONAL INFORMATION section, located below NoR 14. Entries must be received by 2000 hours on Thursday, 30 May 2019. No less than \$100 of the \$150 entry fee will go directly to the Maryland Chapter of the Leukemia & Lymphoma Society (LLS).
- 3.2 Proceeds from entry fees will be donated to the Leukemia and Lymphoma Society. Therefore, refunds will not be granted for cancelled registrations.

### 5 SAILING INSTRUCTIONS

- 5.1 **[NP]** The event Sailing Instructions will be available on the EYC website no later than 2000 hours on Wednesday, 29 May 2019, and posted on the Official Notice Board, located electronically at <a href="http://eastportyc.org/leukemia-cup">http://eastportyc.org/leukemia-cup</a>.
- 5.2 There will be four (4) separate and unique Sailing Instructions documents: one (1) for the Annapolis Fleet; one (1) for the Herring Bay Fleet; one (1) for the Miles River Fleet; and, one (1) for the Rock Creek Fleet.

#### 6 VENUE

- 6.1 The Annapolis Fleets will race on the Severn River and on the adjacent waters of the Chesapeake Bay.
- 6.2 The Herring Bay Fleet and Rock Creek Fleet will race on Chesapeake Bay.
- 6.3 The Miles River Fleet will race on the Miles River, Eastern Bay, and Chesapeake Bay.
- 6.2 A post-race party and awards presentation will be held at the EYC clubhouse after the conclusion of racing.


#### 7 COURSES


- 7.1 The Annapolis Fleets will sail courses noted below:
  - The Alerion Express 28, Cal 25, Harbor 20, and Herreshoff 12.5 classes will sail drop mark courses on the Severn River.
  - The CRCA-ORR, CRCA-ARC, Leukemia Cruising Class, and PHRF N, classes will sail one (1) pursuitstyle race with a reverse-PHRF starting order using marks described in the Sailing Instructions. This changes RRS 26.
  - The Multihull classes will sail one (1) race using marks described in the Sailing Instructions.
  - All other classes will sail drop mark courses as shown in the Sailing Instructions.
- 7.2 The Herring Bay and Rock Creek Fleets will sail one (1) government marks course on Chesapeake Bay.
- 7.3 The Miles River Fleet will sail one (1) government marks course on the Miles River, Eastern Bay, and Chesapeake Bay.

## **8 PENALTY SYSTEM**

- 8.1 RRS Appendix V1, Penalty at the Time of An Incident, will apply.
- RRS Appendix V2, Penalty Taken After A Race, will apply, and is changed to: "After a race, a boat that may have broken one or more rules of Part 2 or RRS 31 in an incident while racing may take a Post-Race Penalty for that incident. A boat takes the penalty by delivering a written notice to the race office or sending an email to <a href="mailto:race.committee@eastportyc.org">race.committee@eastportyc.org</a> that identifies the race number and when and where the incident occurred. However, RRS 44.1(a) and 44.1(b) apply, and the penalty shall be taken at least fifteen (15) minutes before the protest time limit."









#### **SCORING**

- 9.1 RRS A4, the Low Point System, will apply.
- 9.2 Handicapping for classes sailing the pursuit-style race will be in accordance with the PHRF Time-over-Distance Circular Random rating.
- 9.3 Handicap scoring for classes sailing drop mark courses will be in accordance with the PHRF Time-on-Time
- 9.4 Handicap scoring for classes sailing the distance races from Herring Bay, Miles River, and/or Rock Creek will be in accordance with the PHRF Time-on-Time Circular Random rating.
- A boat's series score will be the total of her race scores. 9.5

#### 10 RADIO COMMUNICATION

[NP] Competitors shall have and monitor a working VHF radio capable of transmitting and receiving on VHF channels 9, 13, 16, 68, 72, and 73.

#### 11 **PRIZES**

- 11.1 Prizes in each class will be given as follows:
  - 1st Place for three (3) or more entries;
  - 2<sup>nd</sup> Place for five (5) or more entries; and,
  - 3<sup>rd</sup> Place for seven (7) or more entries.
- 11.2 Additional prizes will be awarded as described in the Additional Information section.
- 11.3 Participants who compete in all three (3) Annapolis-based charity regattas – Leukemia Cup, CRAB Cup, and Hospice Cup – will be eligible for the Weems & Plath Triple Crown Trophy, to be awarded at the end of the season. The final standings will be a combination of race and fundraising results across all events.

#### 12 **DISCLAIMER OF LIABILITY**

Competitors participate in Leukemia Cup entirely at their own risk; see RRS 4, Decision to Race. The Organizing Authority will accept no liability for material damage, personal injury, or death sustained in conjunction with or prior to, during, or after the event.

#### 13 INSURANCE

[NP] Each boat shall be insured with valid third party liability insurance with a minimum coverage of \$300.000.

#### 14 INFORMATION

- 14.1 Competitors in selected classes may be asked to participate voluntarily in the test of a cell phone-based race tracking application in development by the Sailing Yacht Racing Foundation. Details regarding the selected classes, download, and use of the application will be provided in the Sailing Instructions.

### ADDITIONAL INFORMATION



What Is Leukemia Cup? The Leukemia Cup is a racing series that raises funds for research to cure bloodrelated cancers like leukemia and lymphoma. It has raised over \$60 million dollars since it began in Annapolis in 1992. In 2017, over 10,000 sailors around the country took part in raising funds and sailing for this important cause. The Annapolis Leukemia Cup is a CBYRA-sanctioned regatta held annually by the Eastport Yacht Club.
