

RULES

The event will be governed by:

- The current Racing Rules of Sailing. These rules may be modified by this Notice, the Sailing Instructions, or class association rules
- For IRC Classes, the current IRC Rules
- For IRC and PHRF classes, the Minimum Equipment & Safety Recommendations of the YRA of LIS Category C.
- All Boats shall be equipped with at least one operable VHF radio capable of sending and receiving on designated fleet channels 05A and 72.
- Boats racing in the Non-spinnaker Class may use any length whisker pole. Unless changing
 jibs, only one jib may be set while racing.
- Ideal 18s, Sonars, etc. will race under their Class Rules, with spinnakers.
- Multihulls will race with NEMA Ratings, with spinnakers.

SCHEDULE OF EVENTS

Racing is scheduled for Sunday, September 8, 2013. The first signal will sound at 1030.

SAILING INSTRUCTIONS

Sailing instructions will be available at www.yachtscoring.com, the Stamford Yacht Club and from the SYC website at www.stamfordyc.com on or before Tuesday, September 3rd.

DIVISIONS & CLASSES

The Race Committee will form Divisions and Classes from the entries. They will appear on the Scratch Sheets. It is intended that there be two Divisions, each with a designated Course.

COURSES

Course marks shall be defined in the Sailing Instructions

ENTRIES

The Valeur-Jensen Stamford Denmark Race is presented as part of the Stamford Yacht Club's website at the following address: www.stamfordyc.com. The event page will include a link to the entry form and, once posted, Sailing Instructions and Scratch Sheets. All entries and fees must be posted on line by 1800 September 6th.

ENTRY FEES:

\$70.00 for boats 45' LOA or over \$60.00 for boats 35' to 44' 11" LOA \$50.00 for boats 24' to 34' 11" LOA \$40.00 for Ideal 18 Class & Multi-hulls **AWARDS** Following racing, participating captains and crews are invited to a reception at Stamford Yacht Club,

at which time trophies will be awarded.

LATE ENTRIES Late entries will be accepted on-line no later than 1800 on Friday, September 6 if accompanied by

twice the standard entry fee. Very late entries MAY be accepted up to 1200 on Saturday, September 7, at the discretion of the Race Committee. All of the conditions under ENTRIES above also apply to

late entries. No rating changes will be accepted after 1800 September 6.

FINAL SCRATCH

SHEETS

Final scratch sheets as well as sailing instructions may be obtained in person at the Stamford Yacht

Club on Saturday, September 7. They will be available on the website after 2000 September 6.

CIRCULARS Considering the availability of information from the website and at the Stamford Yacht Club, hard

copy of Sailing Instructions and/or Scratch Sheets will NOT be available on the water.

START The starting line will be approximately midway between Red Bell "32" (The Cows) and Red Bell

"32A". The first signal will be at 1030.

The starting line for the Ideal 18 class, if adequate entries are received, will be westerly of the

Stamford Harbor entrance and southerly of the Stamford Breakwater.

QUALIFIER This is a qualifying race for certain YRA of LIS overall trophies and for the Stamford Yacht Club

Trophy Series.

SCORING The race will be scored by calculating the corrected times using **time-on-time** for all handicap

entries.

COMMUNICATIONS While racing, a boat shall neither make nor receive wireless communications not simultaneously

available to all boats and at no fee.
