NOTICE OF RACE





1. Rules -

- 1.1. The regatta will be governed by the rules as defined in *The Racing Rules of Sailing*.
- 1.2. The following rules will be changed as stated -
 - 1.2.1. Race Signal AP when displayed ashore, 'one minute' is replaced by 'sixty minutes'
 - 1.2.2. 44.1– the 'Two-Turns Penalty' is replaced by the 'One-Turn Penalty'.
 - 1.2.3. App A4.2 A boat that does not finish (DNF) a race or retires after finishing (RAF) shall be scored one more point than the last boat to finish in that race.

2. Eligibility, Entry & Fees -

- 2.1. The regatta is open to all boats of the Melges 17 Class.
- 2.2. Eligible boats may enter by going to http://www.yachtscoring.com or boats may enter during registration.
- 2.3. The required fee for the regatta is \$185.00 which includes dinner on Thursday & Friday Night and Lunch Thursday and Friday.
 - 2.3.1. A late fee for registrations after August 16th of \$50.00 will be charged.
 - 2.3.2. Saturday Lunch will be available at the LGYC for an additional charge.
 - 2.3.3. Additional dinners will be available during registration.

- 4. **Sailing Instructions –** Will be available at registration.
- 5. Venue will be the West end of Lake Geneva.
- 6. **The Courses** will be Windward / Leeward courses. Length and number of legs will be determined by the race committee based on conditions.
- 7. **Penalty System** RRS 44.1 is changed so that the 'Two-Turns Penalty' is replaced by the 'One-Turn Penalty'.
- 8. Scoring -
 - 8.1. Eight (8) races are scheduled and one (1) race is required to be completed to constitute a series.
 - 8.2. A boat's series score will be the total of her race scores with one throw out after six (6) races have been completed.
 - 8.3. A boat that does not finish (DNF) a race or retires after finishing (RAF) shall be scored one more point than the last boat to finish in that race. This changes RRS App A4.2.
- 9. **Boat Launching** Boats will be dry sailed from the LGYC. <u>Please remember to bring your lifting bridle for crane launching.</u>
- 10. **Prizes** will be awarded to crews placing 1st through 5th and top Junior (18 and younger)
- 11. **Disclaimer of Liability** Sailing is an activity that has an inherent risk of damage and injury. Competitors in this event are participating entirely at their own risk. See RRS 4, Decision to Race. The race organizers (organizing authority, race committee, protest committee, host club, sponsors, or any other organization or official) will not be responsible for damage to any boat or other property or the injury to any competitor, including death, sustained as a result of participation in this event. By participating in this event, each competitor agrees to release the race organizers from any and all liability associated with such competitor's participation in this event to the fullest extent permitted by law.
