

## 2019 Tuesday Night Racing Series

## NOTICE OF SERIES

- 1.0 The Tuesday Night Racing Series will be governed by the rules as defined in *The Racing Rules of Sailing* 2017-2020
- 2.0 Eligibility and Entry
  - 2.1 Mono-hull boats 19ft or greater
  - 2.2 Multi-hull boats of 17ft or greater
  - 2.3 Skippers or Owners that are active members of the BCYC
  - 2.4 Eligible boats may enter by completing the entry form located on the BCYC website (www.boynecityyachtclub.com) and sending it to sailing@boynecityyachtclub.com or mailing it to BCYC, PO Box 171, Boyne City, MI 49712 prior to the start of the applicable event. Payments may be made by check and sent to the above address along with your application or payment may be made through the PayPal option on the website. Boats will not be scored if the applicable payment has not been received prior to the start of the event.
- 3.0 Classification
  - 3.1 Class rules (LMPHRF, Portsmouth Yardstick, and One Design) will apply.
  - 3.2 Skippers or Owners shall be active members of their class/fleet
- 4.0 Fees

- 5.0 Schedule
  - 5.1 Skipper's Meeting and Registration will be held at the Van Dam Custom Boats 970 E Division St, Boyne City on Tuesday April 30<sup>th</sup> at 6pm.
  - 5.2 Warm up Races; May 7th
  - 5.3 Spring Series (May 14th June 18<sup>th</sup>)
  - 5.4 Summer Series (June 25th August 20th)
  - 5.5 Fall Series (August 27th October 1st)
  - 5.6 Each night of racing will consist of 1-3 races or as conditions allow
- 6.0 Sailing Instructions are available on the BCYC website (www.boynecityyachtclub.com)
- 7.0 Courses
  - 7.1 Courses will consist of Windward/leeward triangle and or Modified Windward/Leeward Course and will vary due to wind conditions.
  - 7.2 Windward legs of the course will be .6 mile in length, but may vary due to wind conditions.

- 7.3 Diagrams will be available with the Sailing instructions
- 8.0 Safety and Support boats
  - 8.1 All boats shall have radio communications
  - 8.2 Safety boats may not be available on a continual basis (as they are volunteers) and therefore each skipper is responsible for an alternative.
  - 8.3 Class rules apply for all required safety equipment.

## 9.0 Venue

- 9.1 Racing will be in the vicinity of Boyne City on Lake Charlevoix
- 9.2 Meeting place shall be at Boyne City Municipal Marina unless otherwise stated over the radio by the Race Committee prior to the start of the nightly race.
- 10.0 Prizes/Awards
  - 10.1 The top 3 boats, from each fleet, for each series, will be awarded a flag. Winners of flags will be presented at the BCYC Tuesday Race Celebration
  - 10.2 Boat of the year
    Boats/skippers that have shown exceptional sailing skills, improvement, enthusiasm, and/or have exemplified the Corinthian spirit of sailboat racing. To be determined by a vote at the end of season Race Celebration.
- 11.0 Insurance

Each participating boat shall be insured with valid third-party liability insurance with a minimum coverage of \$300,000.
