

July 20-21, 2019 Chicago Yacht Club Jackson Park Yacht Club NOTICE OF RACE

1. ORGANIZING AUTHORITY AND DATES

The Organizing Authorities for the Jack and Back ("the Races") are the Chicago Yacht Club ("CYC") and the Jackson Park Yacht Club. The dates of the Races are Saturday, July 20th, 2019 and Sunday, July 21st, 2019.

2. RULES

- 2.1 Races will be governed by the rules as defined in The Racing Rules of Sailing, 2017-2020 edition, as adopted by U.S. Sailing ("RRS"). U.S. Sailing prescriptions will apply, except for the prescriptions to RRS 63.2 and RRS 63.4.
- 2.2 RRS 52 is changed as follows: Power-driven winches and mechanical and electromechanical steering devices are permitted.

3. ADVERTISING

Any advertising proposed to be carried by a boat must be described in the Entry Form. Advertising deemed by Organizing Authorities not to be compliant with World Sailing Regulation 20 may be rejected. Boats may be required to display advertising chosen and supported by Organizing Authorities.

4. ELIGIBILITY AND ENTRY

4.1. The Races are open to all boats of at least 22 feet length overall. Boats must carry safety equipment in conformance with the CASRA **Nearshore** Safety Regulations.

4.2 All boats will be scored using LMPHRF Time on Time.

4.3. Boats may enter these Races by completing the Entry Form available at <u>www.chicagosailracing.org</u>. Entries must be completed no later than 1200 hours on Friday, July 19th, 2019.

4.4. The Race Committee will provide separate sections for double-handed entries, JAM entries, and a section for boats racing in the "30 and Under" Class (open to boats carrying an LMPHRF general purpose rating of 114 and are 30 LOA or less).

5. FEES

The Entry Fee for the Races shall be \$40 for all entries received by Friday, July 12th, 2019, and \$60 thereafter.



6. SCHEDULE The warning signals for the Race are as follows:

Saturday, July 20 th , 2019:	1230 hours
Sunday, July 21 st , 2019:	1000 hours

7. MEASUREMENT AND RATINGS

7.1. All boats must have a valid 2019 LMPHRF certificate, and race in full compliance with that certificate. All Races will be scored using each boat's LMPHRF general purpose rating.
7.2 Time on time scoring will be used, using the following formula: LMPHRF TOT Rating = 650/550 + LMPHRF General Purpose Time on Distance Rating.

8. SAILING INSTRUCTIONS

Sailing Instructions provide additional details concerning the conduct of each Race, and will be available by June 1, 2019 at www.chicagosailracing.org.

9. VENUE AND COURSES

The venue for these races will be the waters of Lake Michigan, with specific starting areas outlined in the Sailing Instructions.

10. PENALTY SYSTEM

Penalties will be assessed as per the Sailing Instructions.

11. SCORING

Each Race shall be scored individually. One race will constitute a regatta.

12. RADIO COMMUNICATION

Except in an emergency, a boat that is racing shall not make voice or data transmissions and shall not receive voice or data communication that is not available to all boats.

13. DOCKING

Docking privileges will be extended to all entered boats at Jackson Park Yacht Club on Saturday, July 20th, 2019.

14. PRIZES

Prizes will be given as follows: 1-4 starters in a section: 1 prize 5-6 starters in a section: 2 prizes 7-14 starters in a section: 3 prizes 15-19 starters in a section: 4 prizes



20 or more starters in a section: 5 prizes

15. DISCLAIMER OF LIABILITY

Competitors participate in the regatta entirely at their own risk. See RRS 4, Decision to Race. The Organizing Authority will not accept any liability for material damage or personal injury or death sustained in conjunction with or prior to, during, or after the regatta.

16. INSURANCE

Each participating boat shall be insured with valid third-party liability insurance with a minimum coverage of \$500,000 per incident or the equivalent.

17. PHOTOGRAPHY AND VIDEO RIGHTS

Competitors give absolute right and permission for any photographs or video footage taken of themselves or their competing boat to be published in any media whatsoever for editorial, commercial purposes, or to be used in press information.
