13 PENALTY SYSTEMS

Add:

13.4 Jury Observation

For the IC 24 boats, on days 2 and 3, a Jury boat may be stationed in the vicinity of the windward mark and may observe the racing. If a Jury member witnesses what he or she believes to be an infringement of a Rule of Part 2 or Rule 31, this may be signaled with one long sound signal from a Jury boat. Any member of the Jury who has observed the incident will be available as a witness at a subsequent protest hearing.
