1. Invitation

All PHRF cruising/racing boats are invited to participate in the Commonwealth Cup Regatta. The Commonwealth Cup is a distance race sailed on Saturday October 5, 2019.

The Commonwealth Cup One-Design is a windward -leeward round-the buoys race for one-design fleets with three or more registered boats. It is sailed both Saturday, October 5, 2019 and Sunday, October 6, 2019.

The Colonel's Revenge Race is a pursuit style race open to all PHRF cruising and racing boats and is sailed on Sunday, October 6, 2019.

2. Rules

The Regatta will be governed by the rules as defined in The Racing Rules of Sailing.

3. Eligibility and Entry

All boats must have a PHRF measurement form in order to participate. Forms will be available at the captain's meeting. All boats must be registered by 1900 Friday, October 4, 2019.

4. Fees

Registration fee for the Commonwealth Cup and the Commonwealth Cup One Design together is \$70.

5. Classes

Eligible classes for the Commonwealth Cup include JAM A, JAM B, SPINNAKER, and Cruising Class.

The Commonwealth Cup One Design is open to one-design classes with three or more registered boats. We expect a J/22 class.

1800 Dinner and Awards Ceremony under the tent at Green Turtle Bay Beach

Sunday, October 6, 2019

0900 Optional Fun Race/Colonel's Revenge as part of the CYC Sailing Series for PHRF boats not participating in Commonwealth Cup One Design. Staggered start buoy race.
