Notice of Race - City Island Cup 2019

EVENT

The City Island Cup consists of up to five scheduled races. One or more races will constitute a series. The organizing authority is the Eastchester Bay Yacht Racing Association, Inc. (EBYRA).

SCHEDULE AND LOCATION

The races take place June 8th & 9th. The start line will be in Eastchester Bay, in the vicinity of 46A. The first warning gun will be no earlier than 1300 each day. No warnings will be signaled after 1600 hours on Sunday.

ELIGIBILITY

The series is open to all sailing yachts, spinnaker and non-spinnaker, with a valid 2019 YRALIS PHRF certificate or a 2019 IRC Certificate, or, for one-design classes, a class measurement certificate and/or other agreed to stipulations.

RULES

The regatta will be governed by, in reverse order of prevailing authority, the United States Sailing Association, The Racing Rules of Sailing, the Notice of Race, and the Sailing Instructions. A yacht shall have a minimum crew of two people on board at all times.

Crew weight limit penalties and weight credits are not in effect.

EBYRA will refer any issues of certificate compliance to the YRA of LIS Technical Committee.

DIVISIONS

PHRF, IRC, One-Design or level divisions shall be determined after all entries are received.

TEAM CHALLENGE

We will offer a Team Challenge Cup, whereby two to three boats from a club or organization can form a team and have their combined scores compete against other teams' combined scores. There will be no extra charge to form a team. Look for details in a later addendum.

REGISTRATION

Application, certificate, and \$80 entry must be received online at yachtscoring.com by Wednesday, June 5th, 2019. Late applications must include a \$20.00 late fee. No applications will be accepted after 8 PM, Friday, June 7th.

COURSES

Courses will be signaled from the committee boat according to course codes in the Sailing Instructions.

THROWOUTS

If five races are sailed, where there is a finisher in the division, the yachts in that division will earn one throwout.

SCORING

Races will be scored using time-on-time based on a time correction factor (TCF) derived from a yacht's PHRF certificate rating, using the formula TCF = 600/(480+PHRF) or the Time Correction Factor listed on their IRC Certificate or the finish position for level and one-design classes. Series scoring will be done using Low Point Scoring System.

Team Challenge results will use Cox-Sprague scoring to determine cumulative team scores.

AMENDMENTS

Any additions or changes to the sailing instructions or scratch sheet will be posted on the YachtScoring website by 0900 on the day of a race, and are effective for that day's race and all races thereafter.

ADMINISTRATION

Eastchester Bay Yacht Racing Association, Inc., P.O. Box 126, City Island, NY 10464. The organizing authority may establish themselves as members of the Race Committee and/or Protest Committee when necessary.

AWARDS

Trophies will be awarded at the EBYRA Awards Dinner in December 2019. Time and place to be announced.
