

1. Rules

The Regatta is organized under the authority of J/24 Biscayne Bay Fleet 10 and hosted by Fleet 10. The venue host is Shake-A-Leg Miami (SALM) and Regatta Park (RP). This regatta will be governed by the rules as defined in *The Racing Rules of Sailing* (RRS)

2. Eligibility

The regatta is open to all J/24 sailboats as defined by the IJCA and possesses a valid measurement certificate. Competitors must meet all ownership and class membership requirements and complete all aspects of the registration - <u>https://yachtscoring.com/emenu.cfm?eID=9518</u>

3. Entry and Fees

A completed entry form must be received no later than 1900 October 11 @ https://yachtscoring.com/emenu.cfm?eID=9518 Regatta Entry Fee: US Sailing Member \$150.00 - Non Member \$165.00 Registration fee includes racing, launch/haul at SALM – see social event in schedule **NOTE: boats entered in Worlds can haul out at RP - \$10.00 per day fee paid by boat owner until Worlds Championship begins measurement 10/19/19.**

4. Schedule of Events

5. Inspection

All boats are subject to random inspection or measurement by the RC at any time. No boat will be allowed to compete without a fully completed and compliant Part D Class Measurement and Inventory of Required and optional Equipment forms. All participants will be subject to verification of declared crew weight per Class Rule 5.1 and encapsulated corrector weights per Class Rule 3.7.2.

6. Sailing Instructions

SI's will be available at registration and online @ https://yachtscoring.com/emenu.cfm?eID=9518. Changes to the SI's will be posted no later than 15 minutes after the Competitors' Meeting to be effective on Saturday, October 12, or 0800 on Sunday, October 13 to be effective on that date. On-the-water changes may be made to the SI's in accordance with Rule 90.2[c].

7. Regatta Venue

SALM, 2620 S. Bayshore Dr, Miami, FL. Competitors will be permitted to use the facilities - city metered parking available and **NO** trailer storage – Off site trailer parking provided. Official Notice Board located in SALM first floor breezeway.

Launching at SALM will be Friday October 11 for out of town boats – Haul out Sunday will be at SALM or RP for any boats entered in Worlds Championship. Will have crane at RP for after racing haul out. Be first in line for measurement on October 19th!!

8. Racing Area

The racing area will be that part of Biscayne Bay in the vicinity of Quick Flash Mark Red "2", $25 \circ 43.266 \text{ N} 080 \circ 12.467 \text{ W}$, approximately $\frac{1}{2}$ mile north of the east end of the Dinner Key Channel.

9. Courses

The courses will be Windward/Leeward courses with drop marks per the SI's.

10. Scoring

10.1 The Low Point scoring system RRS Appendix A will be modified such that a boat's worst score will be excluded after completion of six races.

10.2 Seven (7) races are scheduled of which one (1) shall constitute a Regatta.

11. Alternative Penalties

The scoring penalty rule 44.3 as modified by the SI's will apply when a boat may have broken a Rule in Part 2 of the RRS.

12. Prizes

Prizes will be awarded for the top three places.
