## **LEVEL 35 TOP OF THE LAKES REGATTA**

**CHEBOYGAN, MICHIGAN, JULY 27<sup>th</sup>- 28<sup>th</sup>, 2019**

### **Notice of Race & Registration**

- Management:** This regatta shall be managed by the Organizing Authority and the Race Committee (RC). The organizing authority will be the J/35 National Class Association. This regatta shall be governed by *The Racing Rules of Sailing* (RRS), the *J-35 Class Association (JCA)* rules as modified by *Level 35 Class Detroit (LCD)* rules, this notice of race, and the sailing instructions for this regatta.
- Entries:** The race is open to all invited J/35 & T35 class boats equipped as specified in ORC Category 4 regulations, including USSA prescriptions in accordance with JCA rule 5, "Racing Restrictions" as modified by LCD. All yachts are subject to inspection for rules compliance by the Race Committee or Technical Committee.
- Mooring:** Each yacht shall make their own mooring reservations available at the Cheboygan County Marina (231) 627-4944. Early reservations recommended, as space is limited. The new Harbor Master, Curtis Chambers, said there will be plenty of room.
- Sailing Instructions:** Sailing Instructions shall be posted on Yacht Scoring no later than one week before the regatta and will be available at the registration desk and Skippers Meeting to be held at the pavilion, **Saturday July 27<sup>th</sup>, 8:30 AM**
- Course:** Seven (7) scheduled Windward-Leeward course races. Four (4) races on Saturday and Three (3) races on Sunday (weather permitting). Scoring shall be per USSA Appendix A2. 3 races constitute a series. The starting area shall be west of the Cheboygan River entrance. The warning signal for the first start shall be 10:30 each day.
- Box Lunch:** Box lunches available from Great Lakes Grill. Call (231) 627-8161 to order.
- Awards:** Overall and daily trophies will be presented at the pavilion accompanying dinner. G.L.G. Saturday Whitefish dinner or chicken, potato, vegetable salad, bread, bundt cake for dessert. 8 tickets are included in with each registration. Extra dinners are available for \$20.00 per person. Sunday Dukes Dogs will be at the marina, same as last year.
- Disclaimer of Liability:** Competitors participate in the race entirely at their own risk. See RRS 4, Decision to Race. The organizing authority will not accept any liability for material damage or personal injury or death sustained in conjunction with or prior to, during, or after the race.
