7. Other rules:

- 7.1. These Sailing Instructions includes the SMYC Standard Clauses for Sailing Instructions Small Boats.
- 7.2. Turns penalty: 2 turn.
- 7.3. Discards: One discard if five or more races are completed. Two discards if 10 or more races are completed.
- 7.4. Standard Clause 11.2 is changed: The start line will be between a staffdisplaying a Sol flag on the committee boat and a nearby yellow cylindrical mark.
 7.5. Standard Clause 13 is changed: The finish line will be between a staffdisplaying a Sol flag on the committee boat and a nearby small orange fender.
 7.6. A White flag displayed over a class flag with two sounds means that any boat in that class still racing will be scored in the position that they currently held without completing the source or finishing. They can sail directly hack to the
- the position that they currently hold without completing the course or finishing. They can sail directly back to the start area to prepare for the next start. This changes Rule 28 and Appendix A4.

 7.7. Prizes: 1st, 2nd, and 3rd in each fleet. Additional prizes may be awarded at the discretion of the Race Committee.

 7.8. All competitors have to wear their Sol long sleeve UV shirts during racing.
