Notice of Race

The Fort Worth Boat Club as the Organizing Authority (OA) cordially invites you to the 2019 Ol' Man of the Sea Regatta on beautiful Eagle Mountain Lake.

1. Rules

1.1. The regatta will be governed by the *rules* as defined in *The Racing Rules of Sailing*, and the class rules of the applicable one-design classes.

2. Eligibility and Entry

- 2.1. The regatta is open to all boats with a valid FWBC PHRF rating.
- 2.2. Eligible boats may enter by completing the registration form on <u>vachtscoring.com</u> and paying the required registration fee. Registration URL: <u>https://yachtscoring.com/</u> <u>emenu.cfm?eid=9690</u>
- 2.3. One-design classes may be declared for fleets with three (3) or more entries.
- 2.4. Probable one-design classes include J/105, J/70, J/22, Santana 35, Beneteau First 36.7.
- 2.5. A Cruising Fun Fleet may be formed for boats interested in casual racing.
- 2.6. Boats not sailing in one-design class fleets will be scored using the FWBC PHRF timeon-distance handicapping system.

3. Fees

3.1. The Registration Fee for this regatta is \$100 (US) payable at the time of registration. **4.** Schedule

5. Sailing Instructions

5.1. The Sailing Instructions (SI) will be available at onsite registration and will be posted on the regatta website prior to onsite registration.

6. Venue and Courses

- 6.1. Fort Worth Boat Club and the racing area are located on Eagle Mountain Lake.
- 6.2. The courses to be sailed will be windward/leeward, triangle or point to point distance races using dropped or FWBC permanent racing marks.
- 6.3. Course diagrams will be made available in the SIs.

7. Scoring

7.1. One race is required to be completed to constitute a regatta.

8. Radio Communications

8.1. Except in an emergency, a boat that is racing shall not make voice or data transmissions and shall not receive voice or data communication that is not available to all boats.

9. Prizes

9.1. Trophies will be awarded according to the number of boats in a class, to be determined by the Regatta Committee.

10. Disclaimer of Liability

10.1. Competitors participate in the regatta entirely at the own risk. See RRS 4, Decision to Race. The organizing authority will not accept liability for material damage or personal injury or death sustained in conjunction with or prior to, during, or after the regatta.

11. Insurance

11.1. Each participating boat shall be insured with valid third party liability insurance with a minimum cover of \$300,000.00 per incident.
